

VISITORS PRESENT: Warren Daniels, Parks Foreman, Percy Butler, Parks Crew Leader, Glenn Caldwell, Director of Public Services. D.J. Ory, City Council Member, Gary Lindsey, Terrell Tribune.

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by Mary McCoy at 6:00 p.m.

DISCUSS AND CONSIDER APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Motion to approve the January 21, 2015 minutes was made by Abbie Craven. Second by Diane Cockrill. Motion carried.

DISCUSS AND CONSIDER PARK IMPROVEMENTS: Councilman Ory suggested that the Park Board Members provide a spreadsheet for each park and email it to Glenn. Glenn will sort through the list to determine which items are considered maintenance, capital projects and safety hazards that needs immediate attention. City Staff will price items and come back to the next Park Board Meeting in May to prioritize which items to take to the City Manager. The City Manager will be able to help determine which items from the condensed list to take before Council as a budget item. The City Council will have a workshop in June to discuss budget.

Mary McCoy and Abbie Craven presented a list of items that needs attention in the parks. Mary McCoy asked the other Park Board Members to email Glenn Caldwell their list to review.

The Park Board Members and City Staff have received inquiries about a Skate Park. Mr. Caldwell met with a consultant about adding a Skate Park to the updated Master Plan. Mr. Caldwell informed the Board that building a Skate Park will not happen any time soon but will be included in the future proposal for consideration.

The Park Board Members inquired about adding a Splash Pad or Spray area at Ben Gill Park. Mr. Caldwell informed the Board that he had a discussion with the Consultant concerning a Splash Pad and hopes to have information to present by the next meeting

DISCUSS AND CONSIDER PARK BUDGET: The dates on the Summary Report for Neighborhood Parks needs to be corrected. The balance is the same, nothing has changed. We will have John Rounsavall to provide a sheet with the correct dates.

The City currently has property for future parks but we do not have enough funding to develop one at this time. They are considered as future parks that will be developed based upon the funds

received from developers that are building residential houses in those areas. The developers are assessed with a Park Land and Dedication Fee at the time of submitting their plans. Fees are collected on residential property per dwelling unit that houses any single family

UPDATE ON 2014 USER FEES: Council Member D.J. Ory confirmed that TARA League did pay their Fall User Fees. The spreadsheet will be updated and provided at the next meeting.

DISCUSS MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS: None.

UPDATE ON SECURITY AND VANDALISM: The Parks Foreman, Warren Daniels provided an update on vandalism in Ben Gill Park at the Pavilion Restroom. There was some graffiti on the wall. City Staff removed and re-painted the wall. As a reminder o the City includes Labor along with the materials cost is solely for The Police Report. If there was ever an arrest made then Terrell Police will know what value the crime carries if charges are filed.

Park Master Plan City of Terrell, Texas Summary of Services

The purpose of a Park Master Plan is to provide the City of Terrell with a planning document which identifies park needs and desires within the City's park system, as identified by its citizens and through analysis of the existing parks.

Current Park inventories will be updated and public hearings will be held with the Park Board to receive input from the citizens of Terrell. Recommendations will be made regarding improvements to existing parks, as well as, recommendations for new parks.

A summary will be provided identifying capital improvements with a priority listing for each park. A City-wide Priority List will also be provided identifying park needs and ranking them in numerical order according to the priority established through citizen input and analysis.

In summary, the Park Master Plan will guide the City of Terrell in park land acquisition and development for the next ten (10) years.
