

ORDINANCE NO. 1871

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 9, SECTION 9B, (2) CLASSIFIED POSITIONS IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:

THAT Chapter 9, Section 9B (2) Classified Positions in the Police Department of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Terrell, Texas, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 9B (2)

Police Officers of the City of Terrell Police Department are classified as follows, and the number of positions of each classification thereof are as follows, with the salary per position as stated adjacent to each classification.

CLASSIFICATION	NUMBER OF POSITIONS	BASE MONTHLY SALARY
Patrol Officer	28	\$1926.00

Each police officer as classified herein has civil service protection. A classified position may be filled only from an eligibility list that results from examination held in accordance with Chapter 143 of the Texas Local Government Code.

SECTION II.

All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION III.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the city council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.
