

**ORDINANCE NO. 1885**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1784, SECTION 27: WATER SERVICE RATES, PARAGRAPHS (5) AND SECTION 28: SEWER SERVICE RATES AND CHARGES PARAGRAPH (5), IN REFERENCE TO APPENDIX 1, FEE SCHEDULE, OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:**

THAT Appendix I, Fee Schedule, SECTION 27, WATER SERVICE RATES, PARAGRAPH (5) AND SECTION 28, SEWER SERVICE RATES AND CHARGES PARAGRAPH (5), of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Terrell, Texas, shall hereby be amended to read as follows:

**SECTION I.**

**SECTION 27: WATER SERVICE RATES**

The following schedule of monthly rates or charges for water services furnished by the City shall be and such is hereby adopted and established as follows:

(5) State Hospital Rates: Terrell State Hospital shall be charged on the following basis:

Minimum bill	\$1,400.00 per month
Volume charge for all consumption per month	\$1.50 per 1, 000 gallons

**SECTION 28: SEWER SERVICE RATES AND CHARGES**

The following schedule of monthly rates or charges for sewer services furnished by the City shall be an such is hereby adopted and established as follows:

(5) State Hospital Rates. Terrell State Hospital shall be charged on the following basis:

Minimum bill	\$4,600.00
Volume Charge	\$1.55 per 1,000 gallons

**SECTION II.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

**SECTION III.**

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or sentence.

**SECTION IV.**

This ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
