

**ORDINANCE NO. 1907**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 2 ADMINISTRATION, BY ADDING SECTION 11 PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF THE TERRELL 2000 ADVISORY BOARD; PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENTS TO SUCH BOARD; REQUIRING MEMBERS TO SERVE WITHOUT RENUMERATION; PROVIDING FOR OFFICERS OF THE BOARD; PROVIDING FOR MEETINGS OF THE BOARD; ESTABLISHING GENERAL DUTIES OF THE BOARD; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:**

**ARTICLE I.**

**THAT** Chapter 2, Administration, of the Terrell City Code, Revised is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION 11. TERRELL 2000 ADVISORY BOARD**

**A. TERRELL 2000 ADVISORY BOARD CREATED; APPOINTMENTS**

There is hereby created the Terrell 2000 Advisory Board which shall be composed of a maximum of ten (10) members. Members of the board shall be appointed by a majority vote of the city council. All members shall be appointed for three (3) year terms. Should vacancies occur on the board, such vacancies; shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments except terms shall be only for the remainder of such unexpired terms.

**B. MEMBERS TO SERVE WITHOUT PAY**

Members of the Terrell 2000 Advisory Board shall serve without pay.

**C. OFFICERS**

The Terrell 2000 Advisory Board shall annually elect a chairman, vice chairman, and secretary. The chairman shall preside over all meetings of the board and may call special meetings at any time. The vice-chairman shall act in the absence of the chairman and shall have all the powers of the chairman when so acting. The secretary shall keep minutes of all meetings and perform such other duties as requested from time to time by the chairman.

**D. MEETINGS OF THE BOARD**

**E. GENERAL DUTIES OF THE BOARD**

**ARTICLE II.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

**ARTICLE III.**

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

**ARTICLE IV.**

This ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
