

ORDINANCE NO. 1908

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AMENDING APPENDIX I, FEE SCHEDULE, SECTION 24, SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL RATES AND CHARGES; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:

ARTICLE I.

THAT APPENDIX I, FEE SCHEDULE SECTION 24, SOLID WASTE – FEES AND CHARGES, Paragraph (1) Collection Services of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Terrell, Texas, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 24: SOLID WASTE HANDLING FEES AND CHARGES

Paragraph (1) Collection Services shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

(1) Collection Services

- (a) Residential Rate. All residential units shall be charged **\$9.35** per month per unit for twice a week collection.
- (b) Hand Collection Commercial Rate. All hand collection commercial shall be charged **\$9.35** per month for twice a week collection. The number of bags is not to exceed ten (10) bags per pickup.

ARTICLE II.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

ARTICLE III.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

ARTICLE IV.

This ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
