

ORDINANCE NO. 1937

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS,
ADOPTING THE 1998-1999 BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1998, FOR THE CITY OF TERRELL,
TEXAS.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas and Article V, Section 5.02 of the City Charter of the City of Terrell, the City Manager of Terrell prepared the budget covering proposed expenditures for the fiscal year 1998-1999 and caused Notice of Hearing on same to be published as required by law; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by the City Council of the City of Terrell, Texas, on said proposed budget on August 18, 1998, at which time and budget was fully considered, and interested taxpayers were heard by said City Council, which said proposed budget with changes has been marked "Exhibit A" and made a part hereof, is hereby approved as the Official Budget covering the City of Terrell's operation for and during the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1998 and ending September 30, 1999 said expenditures by said City for and during such time shall be on the basis of said budget.

No expenditures not provided for in said budget shall be made unless the same be in the nature of emergencies and after which emergencies have been declared by the said City Council of the City of Terrell.

This ordinance adopting the budget for the ensuing fiscal year is subject to such application as the President's Executive Order on Stabilization may have on it which order was based on the authority vested in the President by the Constitution and Statutes of the United States, including the Economic Stabilization Act 1970 (P.L. 91-379 Stat. 799) as amended.

THAT this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and adoption.
