

ORDINANCE NO. 1973

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, AMENDING TERRELL CITY CODE; CHAPTER 9, PERSONNEL, SECTION 8, CIVIL SERVICE, PARAGRAPH B. DIRECTOR OF CIVIL SERVICE; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS THAT:

ARTICLE I.

That the Terrell City Code; Chapter 9, Personnel, (B) Director of Civil Service, Paragraph (1), Officer of Civil Service Created in its entirety and replace with the following:

Section 8. CIVIL SERVICE

(B) Director of Civil Service

(1) Officer of Civil Service Created

There is hereby created the Office of Director of the Fire Fighter's and Police Officer's Civil Service, which office shall be filled by the appointment of the commission. The director so appointed shall be in accordance with Section 143.012. Director of the Texas Local Government Code, 1998 Edition and all subsequent amendments.

ARTICLE II.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed. Any and all provisions of the Terrell City Code; Chapter 9, Personnel not expressly amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

ARTICLE III.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

ARTICLE IV.

That this ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
