

ORDINANCE NO. 1982

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AMENDING APPENDIX 1, FEE SCHEDULE; SECTION 2: LIBRARY FEES AND CHARGES; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:

ARTICLE I.

THAT APPENDIX 1, FEE SCHEDULE, SECTION 2: LIBRARY FEES AND CHARGES, of the Terrell City Code, Revised is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

In the event a patron returns an item which previously has been declared lost and for which the patron has paid, the cost of the item less any accrued fine will be refunded to the patron. The processing fee is not refundable.

In instances where the cost of a lost or irreparably damaged item cannot be ascertained, the following average costs will be applied:

(Charges for books-on-tape with multiple tapes will be assessed at \$7.00/tape.)

Information File Materials \$ 5.00

The library director and assistant director reserve the authority to adjust these average costs in special situations such as loss of rare or historically significant materials.

ARTICLE II.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

ARTICLE III.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

ARTICLE IV.

This ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
