

ORDINANCE NO. 1990

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, DESIGNATING SEVENTH STREET, BETWEEN JOHNSON AND MAIN STREETS, FOR ONE-WAY TRAFFIC OPERATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:

SECTION I.

WHEREAS, a request for one-way designation was made by the owner of the majority of the properties fronting upon Seventh Street between Main Street and Johnson Street; and

WHEREAS, the owners of all adjacent parcels, based on the latest tax roll, have been notified of the proposed change and provided an opportunity to raise any concerns relative to the request, and this body having been apprised of same;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Terrell, Texas

THAT, on the first school day following the installation of appropriate traffic control and guidance devices (and the publication of this ordinance as required by law) motorists are directed to travel on Seventh Street, one-way, northeastward, from Main Street toward Johnson Street, between the hours of 7:30 and 9:00 a.m., and 2:00 and 4:00 p.m., on school days; and

THAT at his earliest convenience, the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to install those traffic control devices, in the vicinity of the said one-way streets, which are deemed necessary and appropriate to advise the motoring public and promote traffic safety;

SECTION II.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionally shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the city council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

SECTION III.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION IV.

This Ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provides.
