

ORDINANCE NO. 2014

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A FOUR-WAY (4-WAY) STOP INTERSECTION AT GRIFFITH AVENUE AND NINTH STREET; PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF REQUIRED STOP SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That there be installed at the intersection of Griffith Avenue and Ninth Street appropriate signs, designating four-way stop, in accordance with Chapter 11, Section 36, of the City of Terrell 1986 Revised Code of Ordinances, notifying drivers of vehicles approaching such intersection to come to a full stop. Drivers or operators of vehicles approaching such sign shall comply with the requirements of Chapter 11, Section 36, with regards thereto.

SECTION II.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and section so this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the city council without the incorporation of this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

SECTION III.

This ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provides.
