

ORDINANCE NO. 2020

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 9, PERSONNEL, SECTION 8.: CIVIL SERVICE; PARAGRAPH (2) COMMISSIONERS OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:

THAT Chapter 9, Personnel, Section 8. Civil Service, **Paragraph (2) Commissioners** of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Terrell, Texas be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

SECTION I.

SECTION 8. CIVIL SERVICE

(2) Commissioners

Members of the Commission shall be appointed by the Chief Executive of the City of Terrell and confirmed by the Terrell City Council. The term of office of each commissioner shall be for three (3) years, or until a successor is appointed, confirmed and qualified.

SECTION II

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION III

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this ordinances are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

SECTION IV

This ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
