

ORDINANCE NO. 2027

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AMENDING APPENDIX 1, FEE SCHEDULE, SECTION 28: SEWER SERVICE RATES AND CHARGES, BY ADDING PARAGRAPH (7); OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:

THAT, Appendix I, Fee Schedule, Section 28, SEWER SERVICE RATES AND CHARGES, of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Terrell, Texas, shall hereby be amended by adding Paragraph (7) to read as follows:

ARTICLE I.

Section 28: SEWER SERVICE RATES AND CHARGES

Paragraph (7), Charges for Hauled in Wastes, shall be added to the Sewer Service Rates and Charges for sewer services furnished by the City shall be and such is hereby adopted and established as follows:

(7) Charges for Hauled-in Wastes.

- (A) Annual Permit. Upon application, an annual permit for the disposal of Hauled-in Wastes shall be issued by the City Secretary. A permit fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per year shall be charged for each vehicle transporting household septage to the city's treatment plant for disposal.
- (B) Charges per Load. The following charges shall be made for each load of hauled-in wastes in addition to the annual permit fee.
 - (1) Inspection charge of ten dollars (\$10.00) for verifying that no toxic wastes, incompatible wastes (such as mixed septage and grease trap wastes) or other unacceptable wastes are present.
 - (2) Treatment charge of:
 - (a) \$5.00 per 100 gallons of tank capacity of household septage; or
 - (b) \$5.00 per 100 gallons of a mutually agreed to metering system provided and maintained by the septage hauler.

ARTICLE II.

That the terms and provisions of this ordinance are severable and are governed by all applicable Sections of the City of Terrell Code of Ordinances, as amended. Any and all subsections of Section 28 of Appendix I not expressly amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect and all conflicting ordinances are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE III.

This ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Terrell, and it is accordingly so ordained.
