

ORDINANCE NO. 2052

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 9, SECTION 9(A) CLASSIFICATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS POSITIONS OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:

ARTICLE I.

THAT, Chapter 9, Section A. Classification of Fire Fighters of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Terrell, Texas, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION A. CLASSIFICATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS

The position of Fire Inspector/Investigator is hereby deleted from the Classification of Fire Fighters of the City of Terrell Fire Department and Fire Marshal is added to the classification as follows, with the numbers of position and salary as stated adjacent to the classification. All other classified positions remain unchanged.

CLASSIFICATION	BASE NUMBER OF POSITIONS	MONTHLY SALARY
Fire Inspector/Investigator	0	\$.00
Fire Marshal	1	\$2,459.00

ARTICLE II.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

ARTICLE III.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

ARTICLE IV.

This ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
