

ORDINANCE NO. 2060

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AMENDING APPENDIX 1, FEE SCHEDULE, SECTION 4, SWIMMING POOL - FEES AND CHARGES OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

SECTION I.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:

THAT Appendix I, Fee Schedule, **SECTION 4, SWIMMING POOL - FEES AND CHARGES, Paragraphs (1) through (3)**, of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Terrell, Texas, shall be deleted in its entirety and read as follows:

SECTION 4: SWIMMING POOL - FEES AND CHARGES

The charges for admission to the municipal swimming pool shall be:

(1) Admission Charges

Children under 4 (when accompanied with paying adult).....	Free
Ages 4 - 64.....	\$ 2.00
65 and Over.....	\$ 1.00
Family (up to 4 persons).....	\$ 4.00
Additional charge per family member.....	\$ 1.00

(2) Season Passes

Patrons over 4.....	\$ 35.00
Family of 4.....	\$ 75.00
Additional Family Members.....	\$ 25.00 each

(3) Pool Rental

<u>2-Hour Rental</u>	
Less than 75 people.....	\$100.00
Greater than 75 People.....	\$150.00
2 Lifeguards Minimum, additional as needed.	
Deposit Required with Application.....	\$ 50.00

SECTION II.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION III.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and section so this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the city council without the incorporation of this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

SECTION IV.

This ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provides.
