

ORDINANCE NO. 2081

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE FINANCIAL POLICIES FOR THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AS CONTAINED IN A FINANCIAL POLICY MANUAL; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF SAID ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:

ARTICLE I.

- (1) The City Council of the City of Terrell, Texas does hereby adopt a financial policy manual.
- (2) The financial policies adopted by the City of Terrell, Texas, are herein contained in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance for all purposes.
- (3) Nothing in the Financial Policies Manual hereto attached and marked Exhibit "A" and made a part of this Ordinance for all purposes shall be construed as being in conflict with any law of the State of Texas. In the case of conflict of said manual and any law of the State of Texas, state law shall prevail.

ARTICLE II.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

ARTICLE III.

This ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
