

ORDINANCE NO. 2092

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 11, SECTION 41, SPEED REGULATIONS OF THE 1986 REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

ARTICLE I.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS THAT **CHAPTER 11, SECTION 41: SPEED REGULATIONS, PARAGRAPH C. SCHOOL SPEED ZONES** is hereby amended by the addition of Sub-paragraph (13).

- (13) on Meredith Drive from Farm to Market Rd. 986 (Poetry Rd.), Northwest to Laurel Trail North.

ARTICLE II.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

ARTICLE III.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

ARTICLE IV.

This ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
