

ORDINANCE NO. 2152

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF STOP SIGNS AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF BAKER STREET AND SOUTH ROCKWALL AVENUE, AND AT THE NORTH, SOUTH, EAST AND WEST CORNERS OF THE INTERSECTION OF NINTH STREET AND STATE STREET (FM HIGHWAY 986); PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF CAPTION; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:

ARTICLE I.

THAT there be installed at the northeast corner of the intersection of Baker Street and South Rockwall Avenue and at the north, south, east and west corners of the intersection of Ninth Street and State Street (FM Highway 986) appropriate signs, in accordance with Chapter 11, Section 36, of the City of Terrell, 1986 Revised Code of Ordinances notifying drivers of vehicles approaching such intersection, traveling west bound on Baker Street, northeast and southwest on Ninth Street and southeast and northwest on State Street (FM Highway 986), to come to a full stop. Drivers or operators of vehicles approaching such signs shall comply with the requirements of Chapter 11, Section 36, with regards thereto.

ARTICLE II.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

ARTICLE III.

This ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
