

ORDINANCE NO. 2215

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AMENDING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2003, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2004, AS PASSED AND ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 2, 2003 TO PROVIDE FOR INCREASES IN CERTAIN ACCOUNTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:

This Ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provides.
