

**ORDINANCE NO. 2227**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS AMENDING CHAPTER 2: ADMINISTRATION, SECTION 5: TERRELL PARK BOARD OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TERRELL; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**SECTION I.**

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Terrell, Texas that the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Terrell, Chapter 2: Administration, Section 5: Terrell Park Board be amended as follows:

**Section 5: Terrell Park Board**

- (d.) *Meetings of the board.* The Terrell Park Board shall regularly meet at the city hall on the third Wednesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. The board may by a majority vote change the time and place of a regular meeting to any other time or place. Notice of all meetings shall be given in accordance with Texas Open Meetings Law, as amended. Additional meetings may be called upon request of the chairperson or upon written request by three (3) members of the board or upon notice from the parks and recreation director. Four (4) members of the board shall constitute a quorum and any action taken at a meeting shall require the affirmative vote of a majority of the members present. All meetings shall be governed in accordance with the rules and procedures as established by the board.

**SECTION II**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

**SECTION III**

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

**SECTION IV**

This Ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
