

RESOLUTION NO. 564

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS,
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN
INTERLOCAL PURCHASING AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF
PLANO, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, Section 271.101, Local Government Code, allows local governments to participate in cooperative purchasing programs that allow local governments to purchase from a contract currently existing between another local government and a vendor; and

WHEREAS, the City of Plano, Texas (“Plano”) currently has a contract for products and/or services that the City of Terrell, Texas (“Terrell”) may have a need for, to wit: Redflex Traffic Systems; and

WHEREAS, Terrell agrees to prepare, execute and administer its own contract(s) with the vendor(s), and Plano shall not be a party to Terrell agreement(s) with a vendor; and

WHEREAS, this agreement will allow Terrell to participate in future cooperative purchasing with Plano, and said process satisfies the state law competitive bid requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Terrell, Texas that:

SECTION 1. Terrell desires to enter into an interlocal purchasing agreement with Plano to purchase from a contract currently existing between Plano and Redflex Traffic Systems or any other contract that may exist between Plano and a vendor, as mutually agreed upon.

SECTION 2. The City Manager of the City of Terrell, Texas, be and is hereby authorized to execute an interlocal purchasing agreement with Plano allowing Terrell to purchase from contracts existing between Plano and a vendor.
