

RESOLUTION NO. 566

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE EXISTING MUNICIPAL MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR AUTHORIZATION TO INSTALL AND OPERATE AUTOMATED RED LIGHT ENFORCEMENT CAMERAS.

WHEREAS, The City of Terrell intends to make use of Automated Red Light Enforcement Cameras; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) requires an amendment to the existing Municipal Maintenance Agreement with the City of Terrell prior to the installation and operation of Automated Red Light Enforcement Cameras; and

WHEREAS, The City of Terrell and its vendor, Redflex Traffic Systems, must submit the plans and supporting data to the Texas Department of Transportation in order to be granted authorization to install and implement Automated Red Light Enforcement Cameras.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Terrell, Texas that:

SECTION 1. Terrell desires to make use of Automated Red Light Enforcement Cameras through a contract with Redflex Traffic Systems in order to enhance the safety of the motoring public.

SECTION 2. The City Engineer of the City of Terrell, Texas, be and is hereby authorized to execute an Amendment to the Existing Municipal Maintenance Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation.
