

RESOLUTION NO. 709

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, DESIGNATING THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS AT TERRELL CITY HALL LOCATED AT 201 EAST NASH STREET, TERRELL, TEXAS AS THE SINGLE, COMMON ELECTION POLLING PLACE FOR ALL VOTING DISTRICTS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Terrell, Texas has five (5) designated election polling places within the corporate limits of the City of Terrell, Texas for elections held within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Terrell, Texas recognizes the consolidation of five (5) election polling places to a single common voting polling place will allow the City of Terrell to manage the election process in a more effective and efficient manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Terrell, Texas:

Pursuant to Sec. 43.004 of the Texas Election Code, the single common polling place for all voting districts within the corporate limits of the City of Terrell, Texas shall be designated as the City Council Chambers at Terrell City Hall located at 201 East Nash Street, Terrell, Texas, beginning with the May 2012 Election and thereafter.
