

RESOLUTION NO. 718

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS
RENAMING POOL ROAD TO RANDY SNOW COURT

WHEREAS, Thomas Randall Snow, better know as Randy Snow, Terrell High School Class of 1977, lived a life of significant achievement and great personal courage; and

WHEREAS, Randy Snow was a nationally ranked tennis player when, at age 16, he suffered a farming accident that left him paralyzed; and

WHEREAS, Randy Snow became the first athlete to win medals in three different sports in three different Olympics - Silver in the 1984 Los Angeles Olympic Games for the 1500 meters, Gold in the 1992 Barcelona Paralympics for Tennis Singles and Tennis Doubles, and Bronze in the 1996 Atlanta Paralympics for basketball; and

WHEREAS, Randy Snow won 16 U.S. Open tennis titles (6 in singles and 10 in doubles) and was named International Tennis Federation Wheelchair Tennis Player of the Year in 1991; and

WHEREAS, Randy Snow has been inducted into the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame, the U.S. Professional Tennis Association Hall of Fame and the International Tennis Hall of Fame.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS:

THAT POOL ROAD IS HEREBY CHANGED TO "RANDY SNOW COURT"
