

PRESOLUTION NO. 764

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, CANCELLING THE MAY 10, 2014 GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING TWO MEMBERS TO THE CITY COUNCIL, ONE FROM DISTRICT 3 AND ONE FROM DISTRICT 5 AND DECLARING THE UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES ELECTED TO OFFICE

WHEREAS, the City of Terrell, Texas is a home rule municipality located in Kaufman County, and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with law a general election has been ordered for May 10, 2014 for the purpose of electing one member to the District 3 position and one member to the District 5 position to serve on the City Council in the City of Terrell; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary has certified in writing that the candidates on the ballot are unopposed for election to office; and

WHEREAS, the filing deadlines for placement on the ballot and declaration of write-in candidacy has passed; and

WHEREAS, in these circumstances Subchapter C of Chapter 2 of the election Code authorizes a governing body to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office and cancel the election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that

SECTION 1. The following candidates, who are unopposed in the May 10, 2014 general election, are hereby declared elected to office, and shall be issued a certificate of election:

Sandra Wilson District 3
D. J. Ory District 5

SECTION 2. The City Secretary is directed to post a copy of this Resolution at each designated polling place on or before May 10, 2014.
