**RESOLUTION NO. 767**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, APPROVING AND SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A 2014 FEDERAL TIGER GRANT APPLICATION.**

**WHEREAS**, transportation projects in Terrell, Texas are vital to the mobility, safety, air quality, economic development interests and quality of life for all citizens, visitors and business of the State of Texas;

**WHEREAS**, federal, state, regional, and county funding assistance is greatly needed for transportation projects in Terrell, Texas;

**WHEREAS**, The fiscal year 2014 Appropriations Act appropriated \$600 million for the Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) Discretionary Grant program for capital investments in surface transportation infrastructure projects that will have a significant impact on job creation;

Now, **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Terrell, Texas City Council, approves and supports the submission of a Federal TIGER Grant application requesting \$8,700,000 to be matched with an amount not to exceed \$8,700,000 of non-federal funds, federal and local match funds to support the following transportation projects:

1. Adding capacity, safety, and pedestrian improvements to the US 80 / SH 205 / FM 148 intersection
2. FM 148 (N) from Talty Road to south of Spur 557
3. Downtown and Southwestern Christian College area pedestrian and roadway improvements
4. Railroad crossing safety upgrades from Bradshaw Street to Gardner Street
