

RESOLUTION NO. 815

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING CITY PARTICIPATION IN FEMA COST SHARE PROJECTS WHICH PROVIDE FOR DISASTER RECOVERY AND DISASTER MITIGATION FROM DISASTER DECLARATION #4223-DR-TX

WHEREAS, on May 29, 2015, Governor Abbott amended his Proclamation of May 11, 2015, certifying that the severe weather, tornado, straight line winds and flooding event that began on May 4, 2015, has caused a federally eligible disaster in seventy Texas counties; and

WHEREAS, on May 30, 2015, President Obama granted this request for funds to assist in recovery and established Disaster Declaration #4223-DR-TX; and,

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2015, Mayor Richards issued a letter to Governor Abbott requesting State assistance related to damage caused by severe weather, tornado, straight line winds and flooding during the event that began on May 4, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 803 Hazard Mitigation Action Plan on September 15, 2015, to be eligible for the full range of pre-disaster and post-disaster Federal funding for mitigation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City is eligible for assistance under Disaster Declaration #4223-DR-TX at the rate of 75% federal funds and 25% local funds; and

WHEREAS, on October 6, 2105, the City Council authorized City staff to retain H2O Partners to assist with Grant Applications for Hazard Mitigation; and

WHEREAS, the attached Exhibit A: Project Worksheet TER001C has been accepted to the federal review process and the local match is available in the Fiscal Year 2015 - 2016 budget; and

WHEREAS, the attached Exhibit B: Project Worksheet TER002C has been accepted to the federal review process and the local match is available in the Fiscal Year 2015 - 2016 budget; and

WHEREAS, the attached Exhibit C: Project Worksheet TER003C has been accepted to the federal review process and the local match is available in the Fiscal Year 2015 - 2016 budget; and

WHEREAS, the attached Exhibit D: Project Worksheet TER002D has been accepted to the federal review process and the local match is available in the Fiscal Year 2015 - 2016 budget; and

WHEREAS, the attached Exhibit E: Project Worksheet TER004C has been accepted to the federal review process and the local match is available in the Fiscal Year 2015 - 2016 budget; and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
