

RESOLUTION NO. 834

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, TO APPLY FOR FUNDING AVAILABLE THROUGH THE FEMA STAFFORD ACT 404 HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM FOR MITIGATION PURPOSES AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TAKE ALL ACTION REQUIRED

WHEREAS, natural hazards in the City of Terrell area historically have caused significant disasters with losses of life and property and natural resources damage; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Government declared areas of Texas as disaster declarations DR 4266, DR 4269 and DR 4272; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has funding available through their 404 Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP); and

WHEREAS, the City of Terrell has assessed the community's potential risks and hazards and is committed to planning for a sustainable community and reducing the long-term consequences of natural and man-caused hazards; and

WHEREAS, the drainage area referred to as State Street to Alamo Street is identified as having the potential to cause flooding and loss of life and property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The City of Terrell will pursue available funding opportunities for implementation of the proposals designated therein, and will, upon receipt of such funding or other necessary resources, seek to implement the actions required in determined mitigation strategies;
2. The City of Terrell vests with the Mayor the responsibility, authority and means to inform all parties of this action and take all action required on behalf of the City of Terrell.
